Hospital bed, TV with Malayalam Programming, Custom Wheel Chair, 24X7 video monitoring by family in India, ability to call and speak with anyone she like anytime she wants, necklace bell she can ring etc. One caregiver stays in the futon near her bedside during nights so she always has company.



2. Large private fenced and paved backyard backing to greenbelt. Her most favorite pastime is to sit in her wheelchair in the shaded backyard and feed carrots to bunnies. A special ramp has been built for this purpose. We have friends visiting often and spend evenings with her and have potlucks etc.



3. Hoyer Lift for getting her in and out of bath tub and wheelchair when son is not at home.



4. Elliston Park is right next to the home, where she enjoys to be taken in her wheelchair so she can watch kids play, interact with neighbors etc. There is also a trail close by the home. The peace and calm of her home, her social interactions, deep love from family, and her passion to enjoy nature is what keeps her stimulated and motivated to live past the depression from stroke.
